San Diego Speed Boat Adventures is a fully narrated 13 mile tour on the Big Bay. The witty yet historical narration is done through two-way communication systems mounted in each boat. You will have a once in a lifetime view of Navy Ships and Aircraft Carriers, the Coronado Bridge, The famous Star of India and the historic ships of the Maritime Museum. Take in a breathtaking view of the downtown skyline and get a closer look at some of the wildlife that call San Diego Harbor home.

FAQ's:

Are there any restrictions or weight requirements?

Yes, we do have a single person weight limit of 275lbs. Children under 18 must have a parent or guardian present to sign liability waiver.

Any health restrictions?

Part of the fun at Speed Boat Adventure Tours is that, at times, we will be riding in open water. Although usually calm, the harbor can be choppy at times.

We do not recommend guest with neck or back problems or a recent surgery to participate. Pregnant women should not participate.

What to bring / wear?

- 1. Wear what you would to the beach depending on the temperature (swimsuit in the summer and a jacket in the winter)
- 2. Sun block
- 3. Sunglasses

What if I get sea sick?

Normally seasickness is caused by the slow rolling motion in the ocean. Since the Sea Rocket is moving along at high speeds it normally doesn't bother people that are prone to getting seasick.
